

X-Pack Update to Instructions

Recommended procedure immediately before the very first use:

To speed fill time on the first use, rinse the food-grade glycerin from the X-Pack membrane, as follows. Fill the X-Pack through the red flip port with water (do not use your potable water supply). Close the port, shake the bag briefly, and wait about five minutes. Dump the water out through the red port after five minutes. The X-Pack will now filter water faster on its first use.

Once you have done this, the X-Pack must be disposed of ten days later.

Dye Tablet Label

Test Dye
Add one caramel tablet to dirty water side to test the integrity of the membrane filter. If brown color bleeds through to the drink, do not drink and discard the HTI filter.
Ten caramel tablets included, each containing caramel color powder, rice flour, dicalcium phosphate, vegetable sterols, magnesium stearate, silica and cellulose.

X-Pack Detailed Instructions



DIRECTIONS:

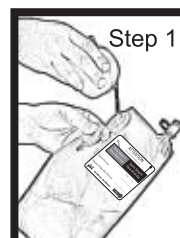
1. Open the red port and fill with dirty water to the bottom of the red port. Do not overfill.
2. Place the test dye into the red port and then close the red port.
3. Remove green cap from spout. Open one Sports Drink Syrup bottle and pour contents down the spout and firmly close the green cap.
4. Wait for 6 -12 hours until inner bag fills. Warmer temps allow for shorter fill times.
5. When ready to drink, open red port and discard remaining dirty water. Close red port.
6. To drink, remove green cap and pour clean drink into a clean container. The drink should be consumed within 24 hours.
7. Close green cap and re-use by repeating steps 1-6.
8. When not in use, keep both ports closed to prevent membrane dryout.

CAUTIONS:

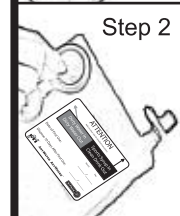
1. Discard X-Pack ten days after first use.
2. Do not use antifreeze or seawater.
3. Human waste and industrial sewage not recommended.
4. Do not allow X-Pack to freeze once used.
5. Do not store in direct sunlight.
6. Once the inner bag has gotten wet, the membrane must not be allowed to dry. Keep both ports closed.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

1. **Drink is too sweet:** X-Pack may need to hydrate longer or not enough water in the dirty water side.
2. **Drink is dirty, cloudy or colored from the test dye:** X-Pack is compromised. Do not drink. Dispose of X-Pack.
3. **X-Pack is leaking:** Check that both the green and red ports are clean and closed tightly.
